We enclose a booking form with reference to your proposed Society visit to Blackmoor Golf Club in 2011. Please complete the forms and return them to us together with your deposit of £100 if this has not already been paid.

Organisers are responsible for ensuring that all Society members conform to the Rules of Golf Etiquette published by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and to Blackmoor Golf Club's Dress Code.

Handicaps

Each player must have a bona fide handicap.

Format of Play

3 or 4 balls only. **Texas Scramble competitions and singles or medal format are not permitted.**

Pace of Play

Blackmoor Golf Club is conscious of the need to ensure that both Society Golfers and Club Members are able to enjoy their golf and, with this in mind, consider that a round should take no longer than four hours.

Club Regulations

If the course remains open and inclement weather persists, a Society is expected to play. Failure to do so will not affect the liability of the Society to pay the total cost of the day.

Members of Blackmoor Golf Club may not introduce Society Members at the Members' guest rate. Mobile telephones may be used in the Clubhouse foyer and Car Park only.

Blackmoor Golf Club operates to a strict Health and Safety Policy and we request that our visitors support us.

Dress Code

On the course

- denim-jeans, tee-shirts, sleeveless shirts (Gentlemen), football, cricket and rugby-shirts, running-shorts and training-shoes are not permitted at any time
- Gentlemen may not wear cropped $\frac{3}{4}$ length trousers
- shorts must be tailored and medium length
- when wearing shorts, Gentlemen must wear long socks of any colour or ankle length socks which are predominantly white – not trainer socks.
- shirts must be collared and must be tucked in at all times
- golf shoes must be worn when playing

In the clubhouse

- the dress code is smart and casual at all times in the bar and dining-room
- tailored shorts are permitted, in the bar only, with shoes/sandals; trainers, flip-flops etc are not permitted; shirts must be tucked in
- wet and muddy clothes worn on the course are not permitted
- hats must not be worn
